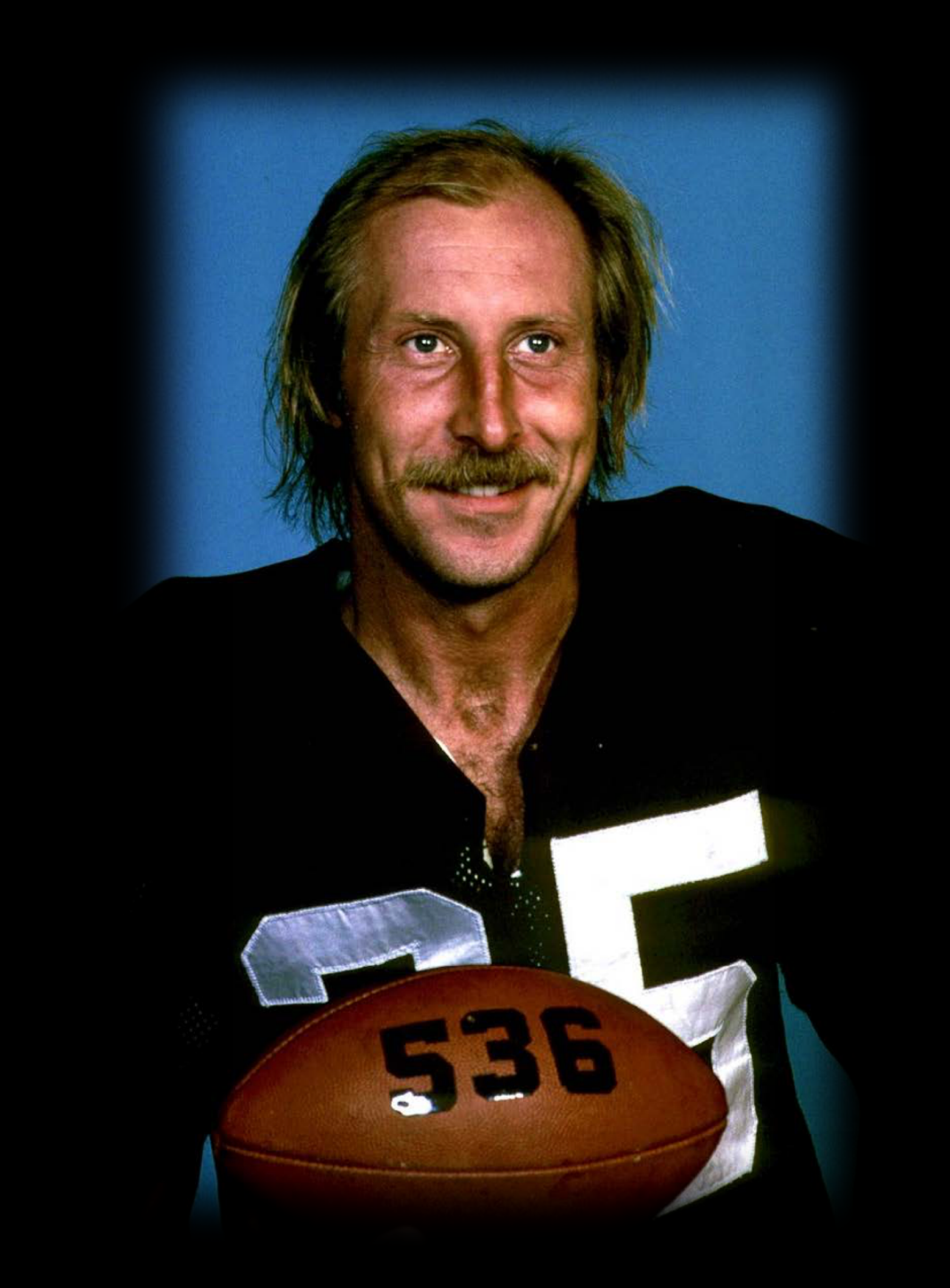

Fred Biletnikoff was All-AFL/AFC selection four times, the 1971 NFL receiving champion, and played in two AFL All-Star games, four AFC-NFC Pro Bowls, eight AFL/AFC title games, and two Super Bowls, being the MVP in Super Bowl XI. After retiring from playing Fred was the Oakland Raiders' wide receiver coach for 18 years, including the 2001 season when the Raiders won the AFC Championship. A true football legend, Fred has had a national award named after him — since 1994, the Biletnikoff Award is presented to young men in football who continue to have outstanding careers in the NFL.
